The meeting of the Executive Council was held at the Front Street Brewery and was called to order at 12:05 p.m. by Vice President Gieck.

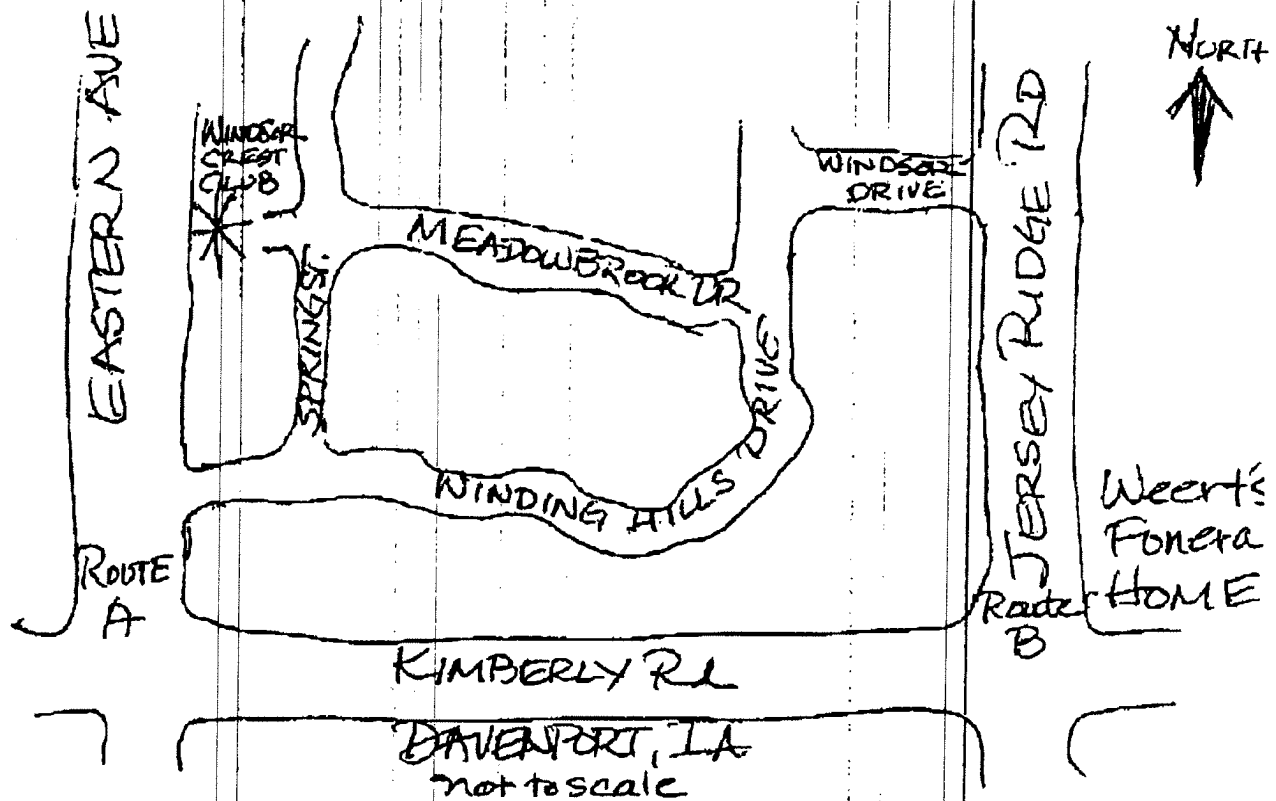
The meeting was adjourned at approximately 12:45 p.m.

Route A:
